The bootlace worm is found on sandy shores and in tide pools. It can grow up to 55 metres in length.

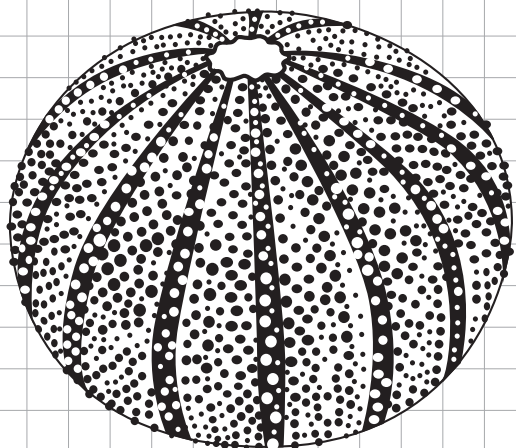

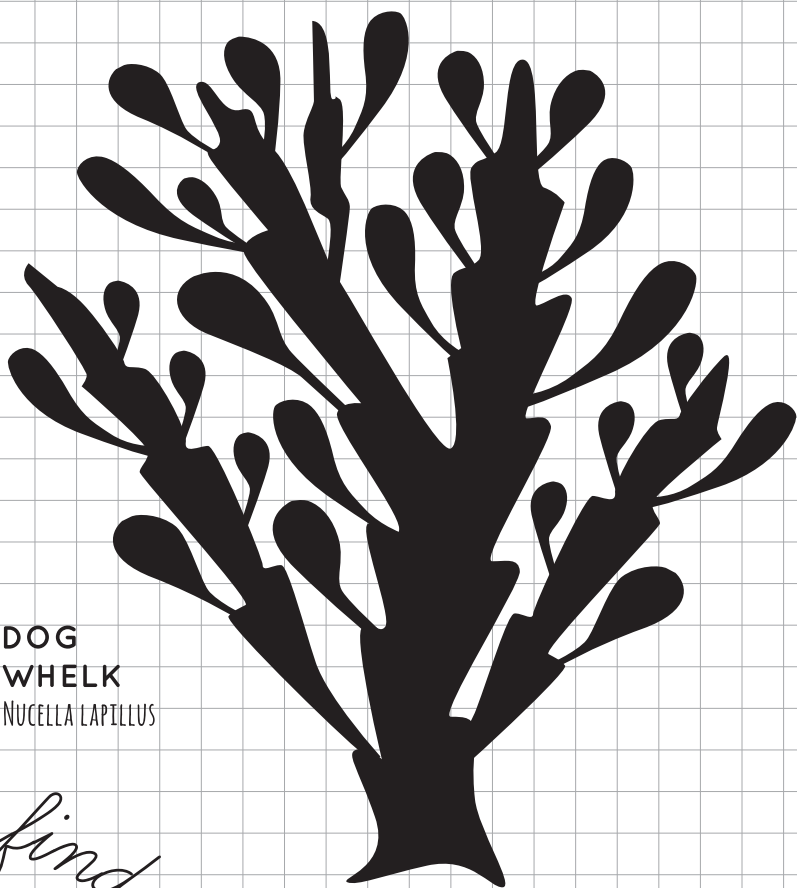

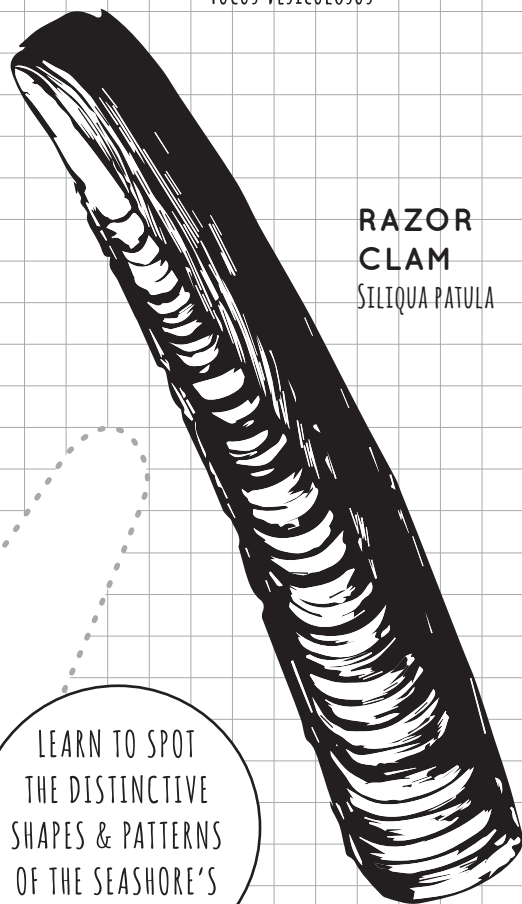
